


Office of the General Counsel Who we are

The Office is composed of 13 legal counsels, 6 legal assistants and employs also legal interns.

LEG functions under the direction and overall supervision of the General Counsel who manages the legal counsels and legal assistants and ensures, amongst other things, the provision of legal services.

 Knowledge sharing: The General Counsel is part of the UN legal network as well as a legal network of General Counsels from IFIs. Legal counsels are also involved with other international organizations' legal networks.



Office of the General Counsel What we do (continued)

Institutional Work

- Interpretation, implementation and periodic revision of IFAD's basic documents. Adapt to global events.
- Provide legal advice on the functioning of IFAD's governing bodies.
- Advise on the legal aspects of policy issues under consideration by IFAD's Management or Governing Bodies.
- Human resources, including represent IFAD in litigation cases.
- Investment portfolio of the fund.
- Procurement.
- Advise on issues in relation to Privileges and immunities of the Fund and its staff.
- Provide legal training to other divisions on legal issues and requirements.
- Monitor and keep up to date with the evolution of international law.



Office of the General Counsel What we do (continued)

Operational Work

- Providing legal input for the design and implementation of country programmes
- Drafting financing agreements with members states
- Drafting Framework collaboration agreements with international organizations
- Negotiating legal agreements, including financing agreements, with borrowing member states and non member states (NGOs or other entities).

Office of the General Counsel What we do (continued)

Legal input on supervision of IFAD projects.

 Legal input in the implementation of IFAD country presence (Host Country Agreement, Service Level Agreement/Country office Agreement)
