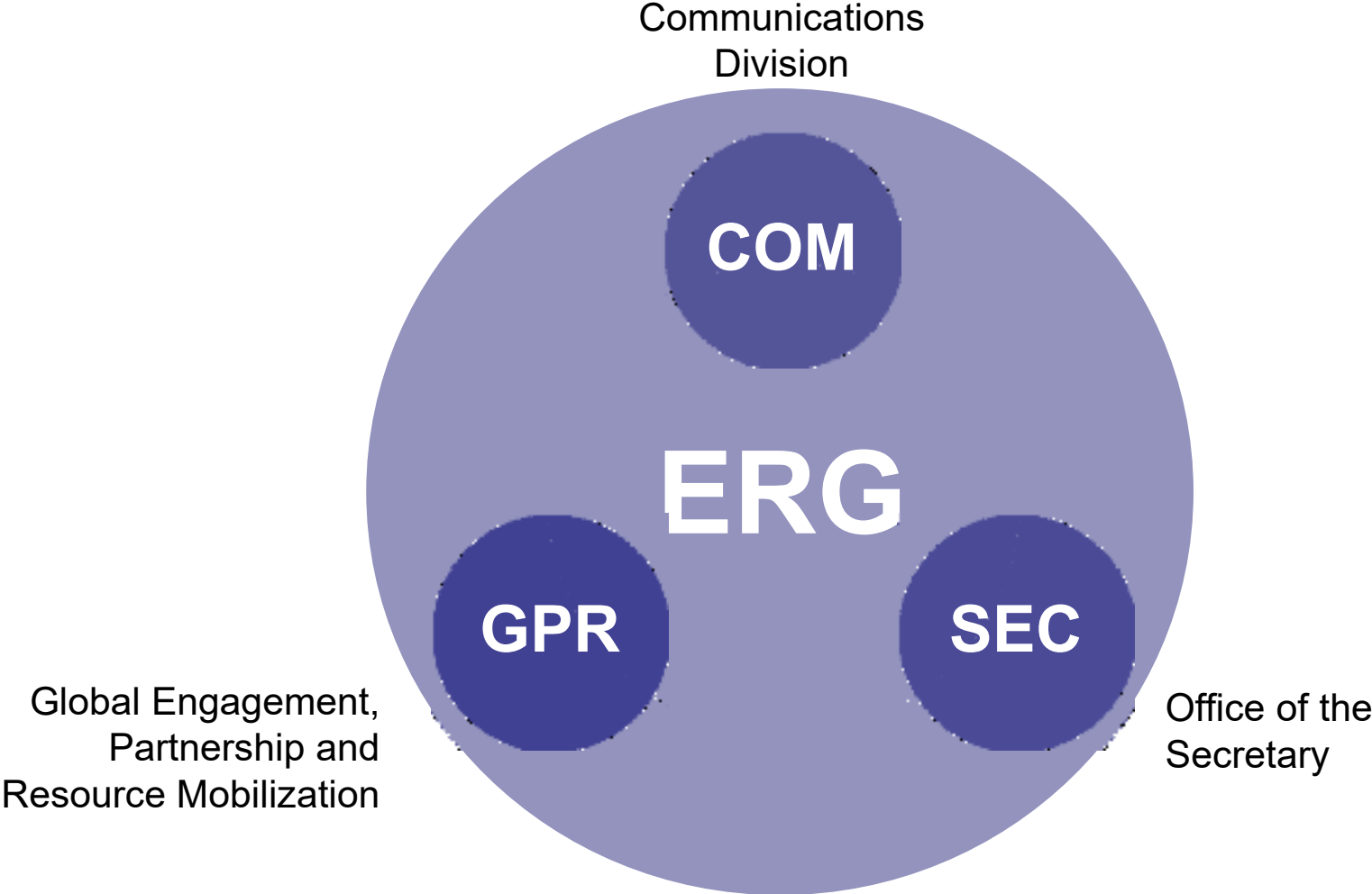


External Relations and Governance Department (ERG) Strategic Objectives

Collective dialogue

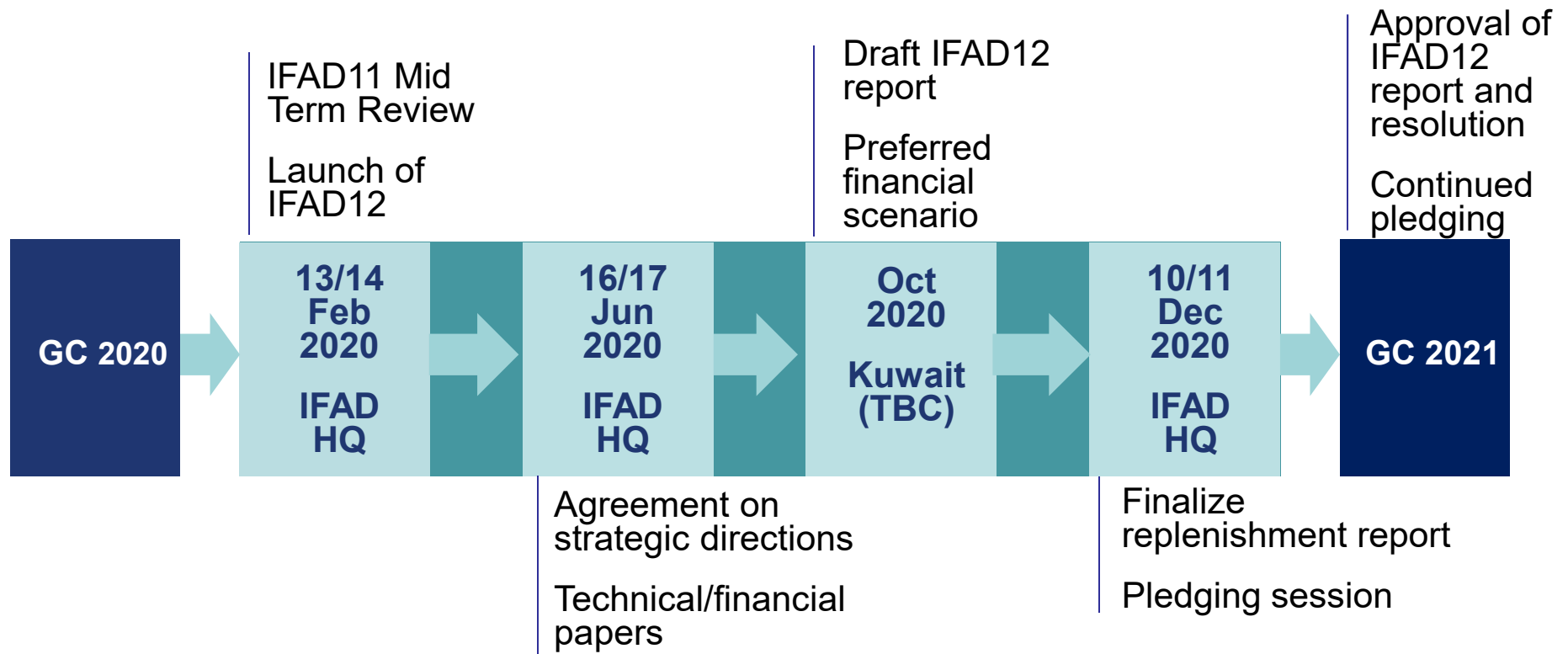
- *Formal meetings:* Executive Board (EB) sessions (including subsidiary bodies) and Governing Council
