Decision-making at IFAD is entrusted to its [Governing Council](#), its [Executive Board](#) and the President of the Fund.





- What is DSA (Daily Subsistence Allowance) and what DSA rates are used by IFAD?**

Daily subsistence allowance (DSA) is an allowance which is intended to account for lodging, meals, gratuities and other expenses of United Nations travellers. The International Civil Service Commission (ICSC) issues a monthly list of rates for different locations around the world. The UN and its related organizations use this schedule of rates to calculate reimbursement for travel expenses on official travel and relocation to a duty station. Organizations may have different policies on how the allowance is determined.

- What is IFAD doing to address sexual harassment, sexual exploitation and sexual abuse?**

IFAD has a zero-tolerance stance towards Sexual harassment, sexual exploitation and abuse (SH/SEA). Since the release of IFAD's policy to preventing and responding to SH/SEA in 2018, a multidivisional SH/SEA Task Force develops biennium corporate SH/SEA Action Plans, which includes concrete deliverables to prevent SH/SEA in IFAD's activities and funded operations. The Executive Board is updated on the implementation of the Plan at each of its session. Prevention being one of the pillars of IFAD's plan, mandatory SH/SEA online training and programmes are provided to IFAD workforce as well as to implementing partners. IFAD policies, procedures, basic texts, contracts have been strengthened to define obligations of staff and holders of contracts with IFAD. As well, Borrowers/Recipients of IFAD funding must comply with the IFAD SH/SEA policy. SH/SEA is mainstreamed into project design and SH/SEA risk are assessed and mitigation measures developed where appropriate. IFAD has strengthened its reporting mechanisms and, under the coordination of the Ethics Office, has expanded its IFAD's SEA focal points programme to all IFAD country and regional offices. IFAD continues to proactively cooperate with counterparts in the UN system and IFIs networks to ensure it adopts the best practices in safeguarding against SH/SEA.
