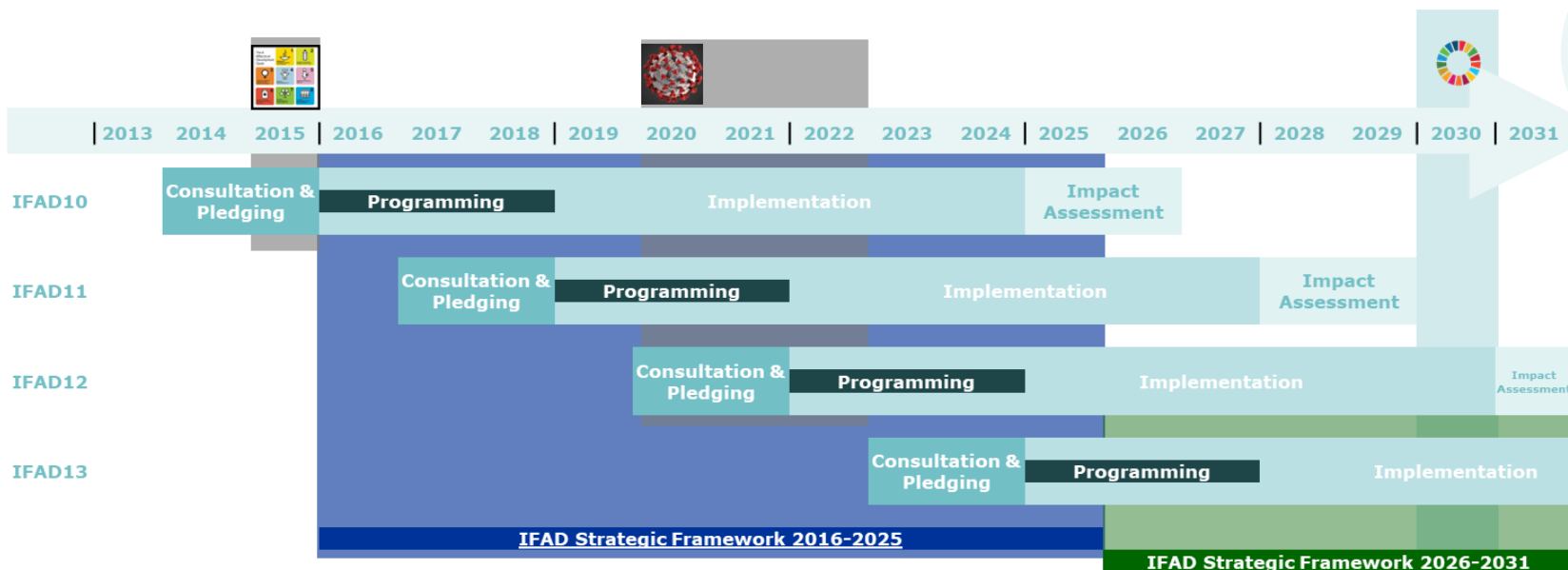

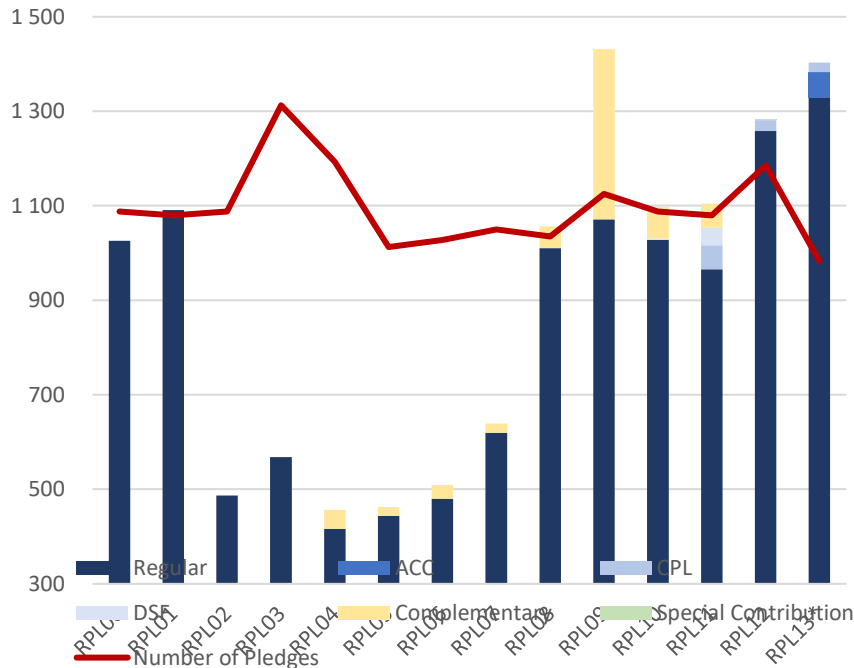

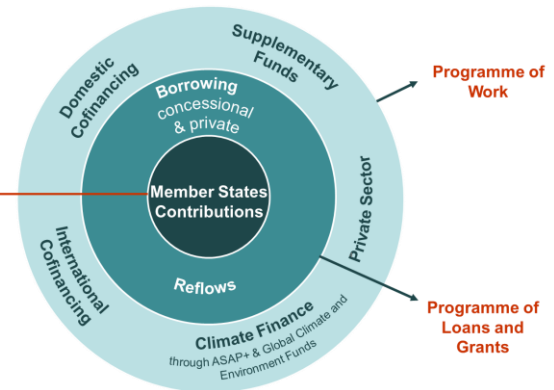
Replenishment is the basis of IFAD's funding

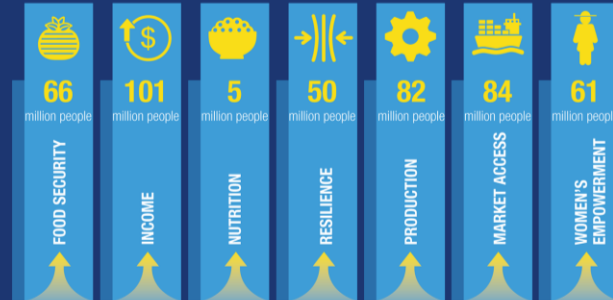
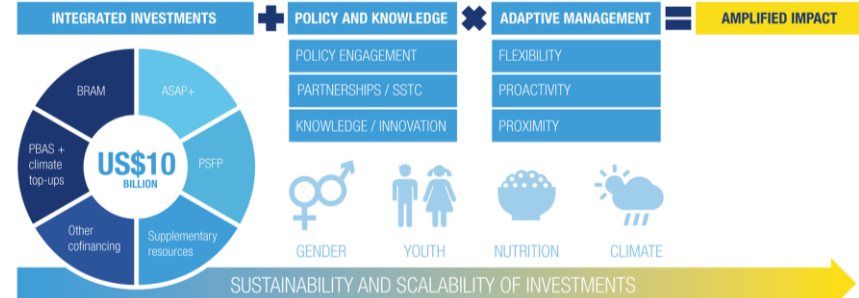

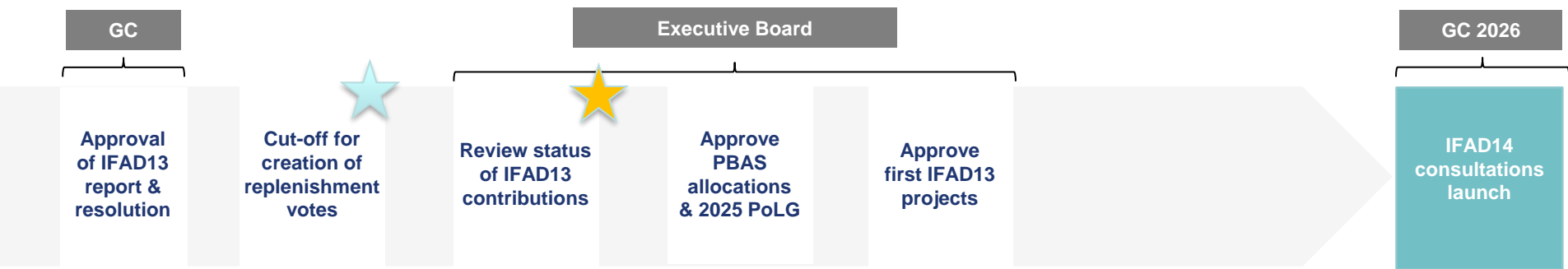
