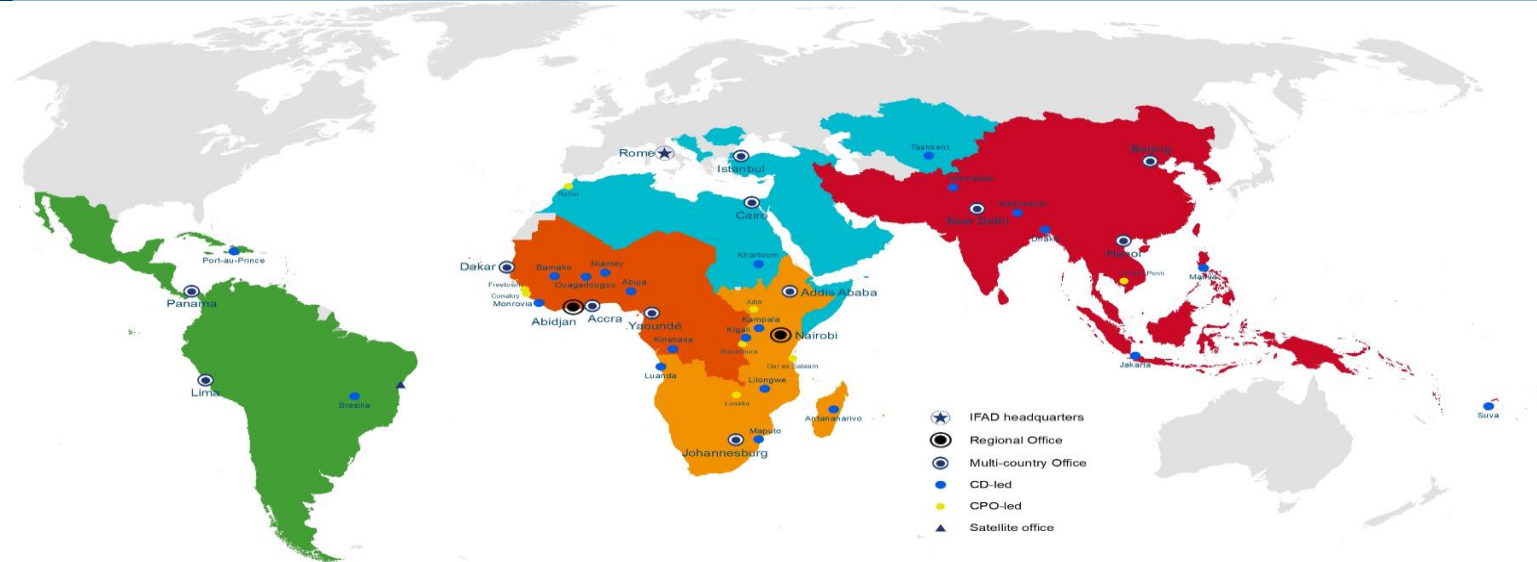

Status Update

HCA

- The signing ceremony is scheduled to take place in Rome on 14 October

Premises

- UNESCAP will provide office space for the establishment of IFAD APR Regional Office. As of January 2025, they will be able to host IFAD initial group of staff members (up to 20 people) who will be relocating to Bangkok. From July 2025, further to the completion of renovation works at the compound, they will make available to us the space to accommodate the entire number of IFAD colleagues assigned to the duty station (approximately 60-65).
- The Thai government will financially contribute bearing the rental costs of the premises.

Status Update

HCA

- New HCA finalized and signed by the two parties

Premises

- Long term premises are under construction in the Ciudad del Saber Compound and are expected to be ready for occupancy by March 2026 the latest.
- In the meantime, IFAD will set up the Regional Office in another appropriate block in the same compound available for occupancy as of beginning of 2025.
- The Panama Government will financially contribute bearing the rental costs of the premises (temporary and definitive).

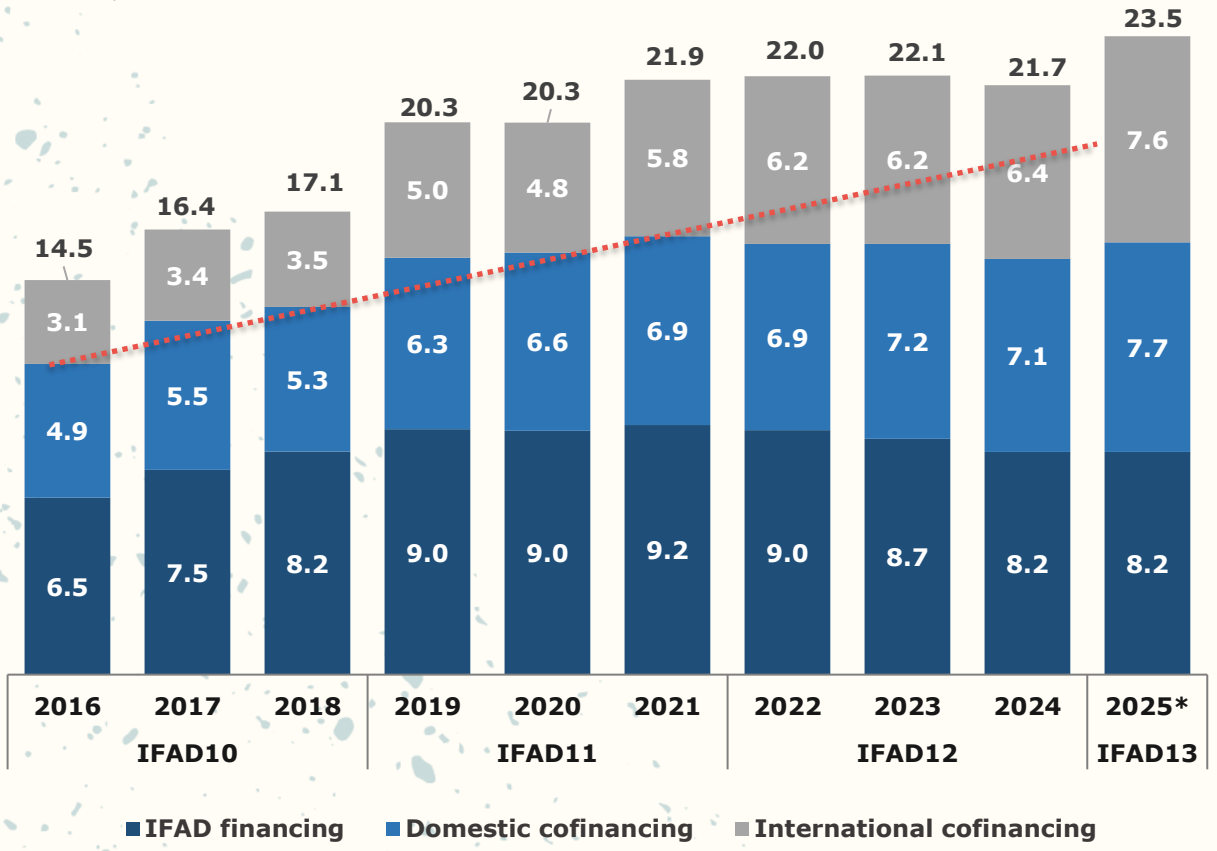

Active Programme of Work

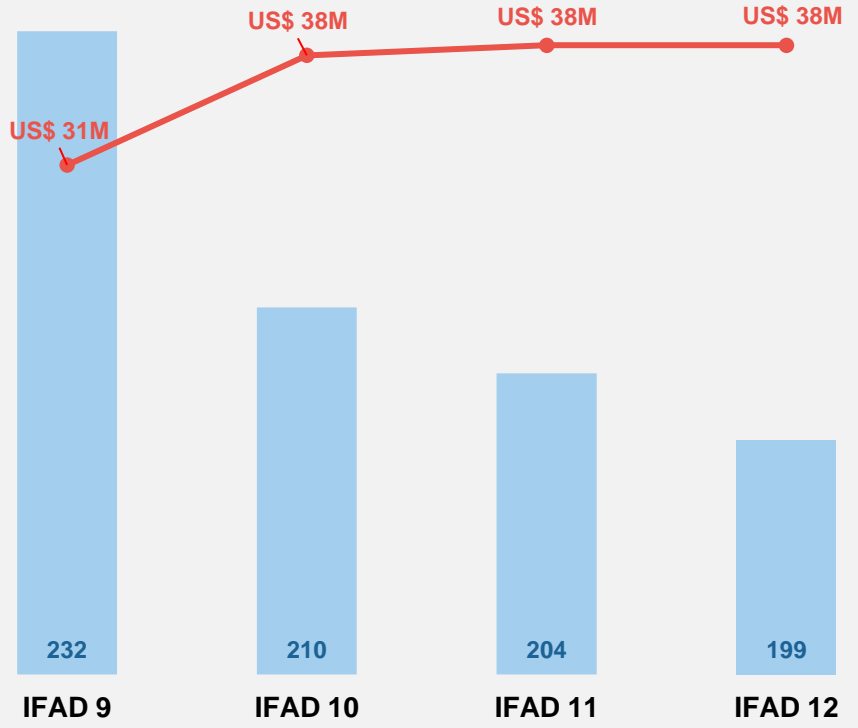
US\$ billion

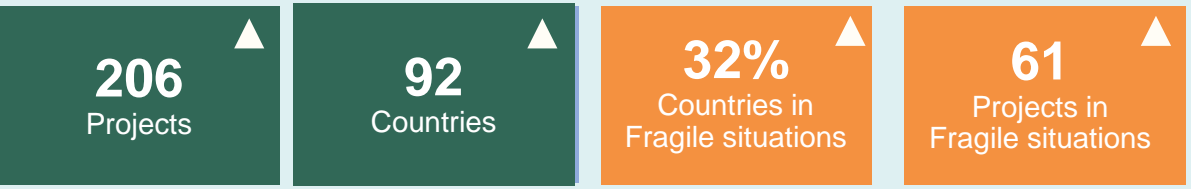


Legend: ■ Avg. yearly number of ongoing projects —●— Avg. project size - IFAD financing (US\$ M)

Investment portfolio dimensions



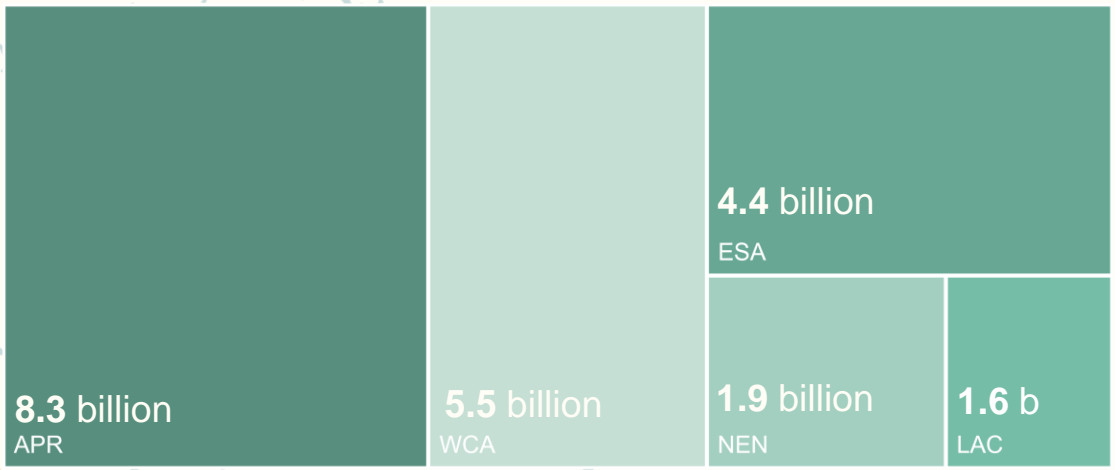

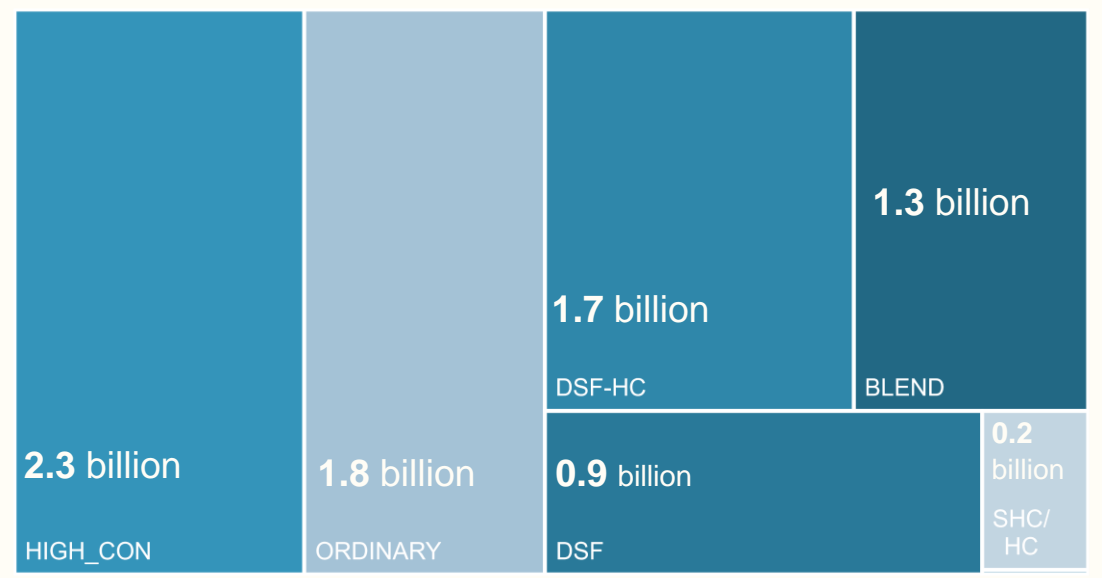
Active portfolio by region

Active portfolio by Financing Terms

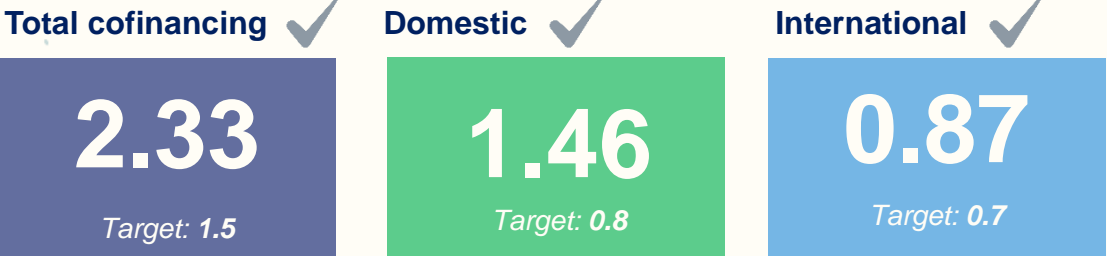

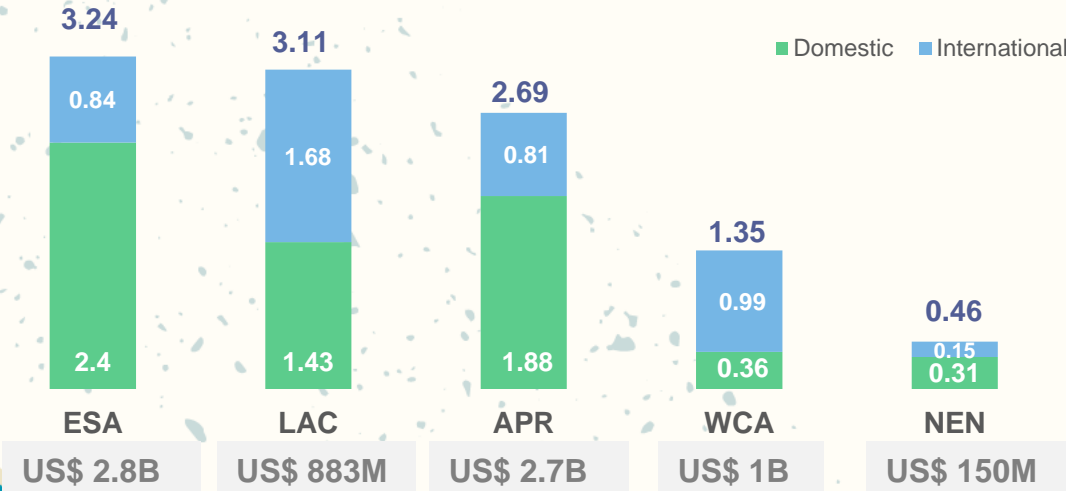
Ongoing Portfolio Cofinancing Ratios

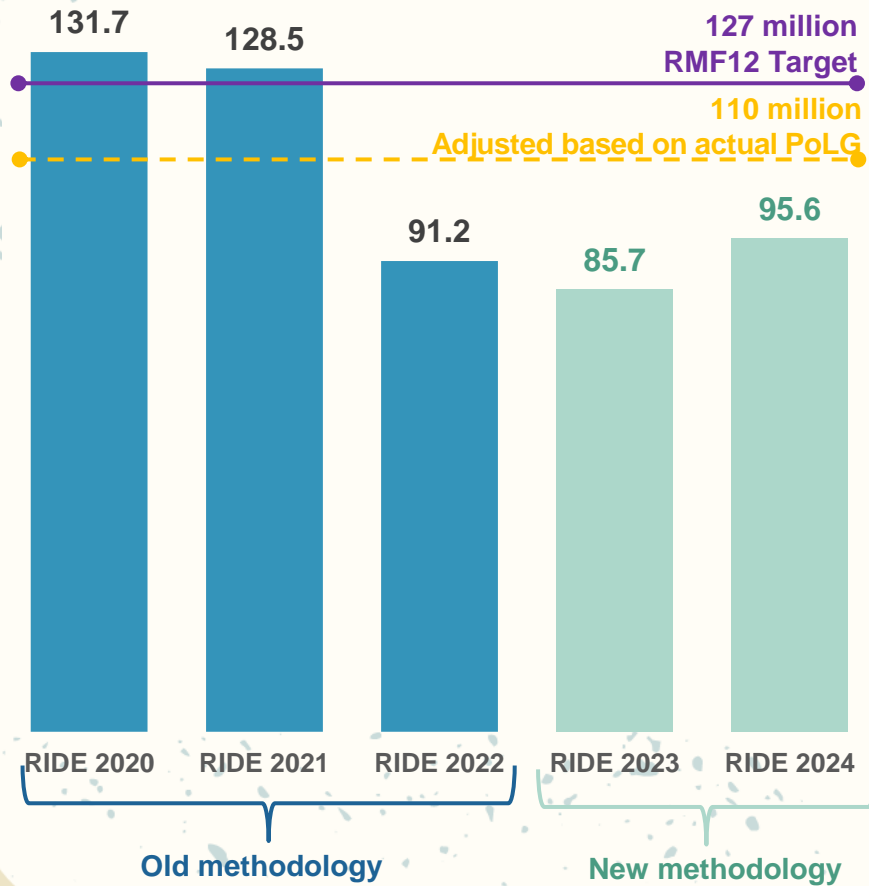

IFAD cumulative outreach, 2020-2024

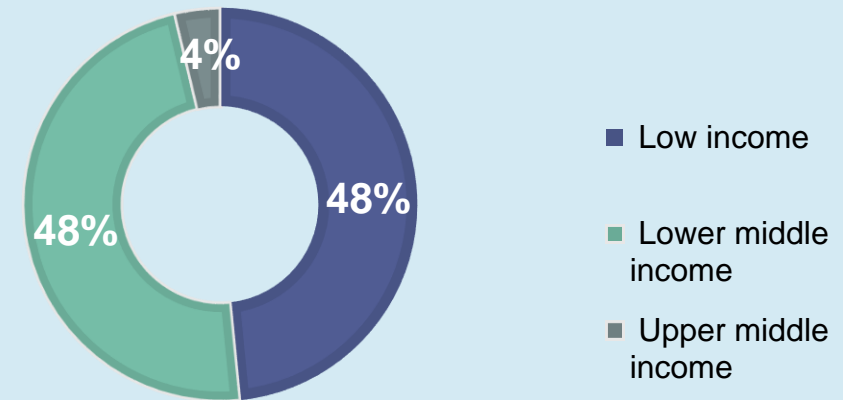


➤ **45% of outreach from 5 projects** based in Ethiopia, Bangladesh, Malawi and Zambia
