Report on the status of contributions to the Ninth Replenishment of IFAD's Resources

- 1. For the information of the Governing Council, the present document contains the following annexes:
 - Annex I Summary of the status of contributions to the Ninth Replenishment as at 30 September 2012
 - Annex II Status of Member States' contributions to the Ninth Replenishment as at 30 September 2012
- 2. As shown in the summary table in annex I of this report, total pledges as at 30 September 2012, including complementary contributions, amounted to US\$1,404,948,444 equivalent, corresponding to 94 per cent of the Ninth Replenishment target of US\$1.5 billion. Member States that have not yet pledged and those intending to increase their contribution are being urged to communicate their pledges to the Fund as soon as possible.
- 3. Annex II shows the details of Member States' contributions to the Ninth Replenishment as at 30 September 2012.
- 4. As at 30 September 2012, instruments of contribution deposited amounted to US\$425.7 million or 30 per cent of pledges. Member States whose instruments of contribution have not yet been deposited are being requested to take the necessary action.
- 5. As at 30 September 2012, advance payments for the Ninth Replenishment had been received from Member States in an amount totalling US\$85.2 million equivalent, or 6 per cent of pledges.

In 1992, the Socialist Republic of Yugoslavia was dissolved and its membership with the Fund terminated *ipso facto*. None of the republics of the former Yugoslavia were permitted to succeed to or continue the membership of Yugoslavia in IFAD. No contribution or payment was due by IFAD to Yugoslavia at the time of its dissolution, nor by Yugoslavia to IFAD.

Canada's pledge includes a core contribution of CAD 75 million and complementary contribution of CAD 19.8 million for the Adaptation for Smallholder Agriculture Programme.

^m United Kingdom's pledge includes a core contribution of GBP 51.1 million and complementary contribution of GBP 150 million for the Adaptation for Smallholder Agriculture Programme.

ⁿ The Netherlands' pledge includes a core contribution of US\$75.0 million, subject to parliamentary approval. The Netherlands is considering a complementary contribution pledge of up to a maximum value of EUR 60 million for the Adaptation for Smallholder Agriculture Programme.
