Addendum

1. The Executive Board is invited to take note of the attached additional information relating to the progress report on implementation of the performance-based allocation system (EB 2014/113/R.2).
2. Annex I contains the 2014 country scores by region and the country allocations for the Ninth Replenishment of IFAD's Resources (2013-2015), indicating both the annual country allocations for 2013, 2014 and 2015 and the updated country allocations for the 2013-2015 period. In order to improve the management of allocations in the three-year period, amounts for countries that are expected to use only part of their potential allocation have been capped at the expected level of financing.
3. Annex II presents details of the rural development sector framework assessments for 2014, in line with the criteria for such assessments set out in document EB 2003/80/R.3. These assessments form the basis for the rural sector performance score in the total performance rating used for the country score and country allocation.
4. Annex III contains the Debt Sustainability Framework classification for 2015.
