Appointment of members to the Evaluation Committee

A. Background

- 1. The Evaluation Committee was established by decision of the Executive Board at the Board's thirty-second session in December 1987, pursuant to rule 11 of the Rules of Procedures of the Executive Board.
- 2. At its sixty-first session, the Executive Board decided that the Evaluation Committee's membership should be in line with the current composition of the Executive Board, as follows:

List A: 4 seats List B: 2 seats List C: 3 seats

- 3. The seats would be inclusive of the chairperson. It was further agreed that the chair of the Evaluation Committee would rest permanently with Lists B and C, and that rotation of the chair was the prerogative of List B and C members.
- 4. At its 102nd session, the Executive Board approved the terms of reference and rules of procedure of the Evaluation Committee, as well as the revised IFAD Evaluation Policy.¹ These new terms of reference and rules of procedure can be accessed on the IFAD website (document EB 2011/102/R.47/Rev.1).
- 5. At its 105th session, the Executive Board endorsed the appointment of the following members to the Evaluation Committee for a term of office to end in April 2015:

List A: Canada,² Finland, Luxembourg³ and Norway List B: Indonesia and Nigeria List C: Sub-List C1: Egypt (until December 2013) Angola (from January 2014 to April 2015) Sub-List C2: India Sub-List C3: Brazil (until October 2013) Mexico (from November 2013 to April 2015)

- 6. In accordance with rule 11.1 of the Rules of Procedures of the Executive Board and rule 1.2 of the Rules of Procedure of the Evaluation Committee, the Executive Board is hereby invited to approve the appointment of the members of the Evaluation Committee for the three-year period ending in April 2018.
- 7. The attachment to this document, provided for reference purposes, sets out the new Executive Board composition as elected at the thirty-eighth session of the Governing Council on 17 February 2015.
