The attention of the Executive Board is drawn to the following corrigendum to the 2018 Annual Report on Results and Impact of IFAD Operations (EB 2018/124/R.12). For ease of reference, an addition to the document is shown in boldface, while underscore indicates deleted text.

Page vii, paragraph 19

The paragraph should read:

“According to IOE ratings (see table 2 below), currently only one out of the 10 outcome indicators has reached the IFAD10 RMF targets: adaptation to climate change ___ is 31 percentage points above the target based on the limited number of ratings from the past two years.¹ Five indicators are within 10 percentage points ___ below the RMF targets namely, innovation, scaling up, rural poverty impact, ENRM and government performance. Two indicators (effectiveness and GEWE) are 15 points ___ below target, while efficiency and sustainability are over 20 points ___ away from 2018 targets. The underperforming indicators will require special attention for the successful completion of IFAD10. ”

¹ Moving averages in the 2014-2016 cohorts include 44 projects in all evaluation data and 36 projects in the PCR/V/PPE data series in which adaptation to climate change was rated separately.
