Projects/Programmes and Grants Approved under the Lapse-of-Time and Delegation of Authority Procedures in 2019

- 1. At its ninety-eighth session in December 2009, the Executive Board adopted a resolution amending its Rules of Procedure by inclusion of a new lapse-of-time (LOT) procedure, effective 1 January 2010 (EB 2009/98/R.15/Rev.1), with the understanding that at each Board session IFAD Management would submit an information note listing all projects/programmes approved through the LOT procedure in the preceding period (EB 2013/110/R.4).
- 2. At its 110th session in December 2013, the Executive Board approved the introduction of a fit-for-purpose approach with respect to the Executive Board documents presenting the list of projects/programmes approved under the LOT procedure, which would be submitted to one Board session per year.
- 3. At its 126th session, the Executive Board approved the Proposals for Streamlining the Approval of IFAD-funded Projects and Programmes to approve projects in accordance with criteria set forth in document EB 2019/126/R.48/Rev.2, which included the Delegation of Authority (DoA) to the President.
- 4. Pursuant to the above, Management wishes to inform the Board that in the period between January and December 2019 the following proposals were approved under the LOT procedure: 18 projects/programmes (see table 1) and 10 grants (see table 2). In addition, four proposals were approved under the DoA procedure (see table 3).
