- 3. What are the key partnerships IFAD should invest in to make precision agriculture available and affordable to its beneficiaries?
- 4. How best to integrate precision agriculture into IFAD's work as a tool for rural transformation and youth employment (i.e. Information and Communication Technology for Development (ICT4D), knowledge management, innovation and provision of services along the value chain)? For instance, should precision agriculture be a priority of IFAD's ICT4D strategy?
- 5. What strategic actions (among partnerships, capacity development, and resource mobilization) should be prioritized to provide IFAD with the capabilities that it needs to effectively and efficiently deliver on this agenda?
