RESOURCES AVAILABLE FOR COMMITMENT

- 1. For the information of the Executive Board, Attachments I and II provide details regarding the resources available for commitment under IFAD's Regular Programme as at 30 June 1998.
- 2. Attachment I shows that the net resources available for commitment as at 30 June 1998 stood at USD 445 million, applying 30 June 1998 exchange rates.
- 3. The resources available for commitment as at 30 June 1998 include USD 201.3 million received in cash and promissory notes towards Fourth Replenishment contributions. This does not include either the complementary contribution from Belgium to the Fourth Replenishment of USD 21.4 million, of which USD 9.5 million has been received in promissory notes as at 30 June 1998, or the complementary contribution from The Netherlands to the Fourth Replenishment of USD 13.1 million as at 30 June 1998.
- 4. Attachment II provides details of Member States' contributions specifically excluded from commitable resources as at 30 June 1998.
- 5. Attachment III provides details of loans and grants approved by the Executive Board at the Sixty-Third Session in April 1998.
- 6. Loans and grants amounting to approximately SDR 111 million are being presented to this Session of the Executive Board.
