RESOURCES AVAILABLE FOR COMMITMENT

- For the information of the Executive Board, Attachments I and II provide details regarding the resources available for commitment under IFAD's Regular Programme as at 30 June 1999.
- Attachment I shows that the net resources available for commitment as at 30 June 1999 stood at USD 355.4 million based on 30 June 1999 exchange rates.
- 3. The resources available for commitment as at 30 June 1999 do not include the complementary contribution of USD 20 481 840 from the Kingdom of Belgium to the Fourth Replenishment, of which USD 17 274 077 has been received in promissory notes; the complementary contribution from the Kingdom of The Netherlands to the Fourth Replenishment equivalent to USD 12 486 556, of which USD 3 868 875 has been received in cash as at 30 June 1999; or the advance contribution from the Republic of Panama of USD 16 600. However, the USD 355.4 million figure includes the special cash contribution from the Republic of Iceland of USD 10 000 as at 30 June 1999 and that from a private individual of USD 38.
- Attachment II provides details on Members' contributions specifically excluded from committable resources as at 30 June 1999.
- 5. The Executive Board is informed that, subsequent to 30 June 1999, the following amounts have been received: USD 40 000 in cash from Angola; USD 7 500 in cash from Turkey; and USD 12 325 994 in promissory notes from Japan. The cash from Angola represents full payment of its Fourth Replenishment contribution; the Turkish and Japanese payments represent part payment of their respective Fourth Replenishment contributions.
- Attachment IV provides details of projects and grants approved by the Executive Board at its Sixty-Sixth Session in April 1999.
- 7. Attachment V provides details on projects and grants, amounting to approximately SDR 66.5 million (USD 88.8 million), applying the exchange rate of 30 June 1999, which are being presented to the current session of the Executive Board.
