RESOURCES AVAILABLE FOR COMMITMENT

- For the information of the Executive Board, and as stated in document EB 2004/81/R.7, management has prepared an update to the estimated resources available for commitment under IFAD's Regular Programme as at 31 March 2004. As per the information in the following paragraph, no additional advance commitment authority (ACA) is being requested at this session of the Executive Board.
- According to the new practice for ACA, under the Sixth Replenishment resolution "total net flows" will be maintained as resources available for commitment. During the period January to March 2004, the total net flows were estimated to be USD 151.1 million. This includes an amount of USD 1.8 million received from the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya in payment of outstanding Third Replenishment contributions. Accordingly, as shown in Attachment I, net resources available for commitment as at 31 March 2004 stood at USD 151.1 million. Attachment I also shows the expected total net inflows until 31 December 2004. Taking into account the loans and grants presented for approval at this Board session of USD 58.2 million as shown in Attachment II, net resources available for commitment carried forward would be some USD 92.9 million.
