### STATUS REPORT ON ARREARS IN PRINCIPAL, INTEREST AND SERVICE CHARGE PAYMENTS

1. This report presents updated information on the status of arrears as at 30 November 2005. It comprises the following summaries:

2. There are no new instances of borrowers with agreed settlement plans. Borrowers under existing settlement plans, i.e. the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Guinea-Bissau and Sierra Leone, have been approved to receive debt relief under the Debt Initiative for Heavily Indebted Poor Countries (HIPC) and, therefore, the arrears shown in this report will be cleared once the respective completion points have been reached.
