Amendment to Rule 7: Representatives of Members and Alternates

1. At the request of the German delegation, the attention of the Executive Board is invited to the proposed amendment to Rule 7 - Representatives of Members and Alternates - of the Rules of Procedure of the Executive Board. For ease of reference, deleted text is shown in square brackets and new text is underlined and in boldface.

Rule 7: Representatives of Members and Alternates

"Each member and alternate attending a session of the Board shall be represented by [the representative whose name] <u>up to two representatives</u>, <u>with only one representative being permitted to speak on any one item of the agenda.</u>

<u>The names</u> shall be communicated to the President by the official channel established by the State concerned...²

2. The Executive Board is invited to consider this proposed amendment and review its possible implementation in 2008.

² At its First Session on 14 December 1977, the Executive Board noted that membership of the Executive Board consisted of the Members States of IFAD. <u>At its ninety-first session</u>, <u>the Executive Board decided that</u>, <u>each</u> Member State and Alternate Member State would nominate [one representative] <u>up to two representatives</u>, who will be expected to serve for the full tenure of that State's membership......"
