Appointment of members to the Evaluation Committee

A. Background

- 1. The Evaluation Committee was established by decision of the Executive Board at the Board's thirty-second session in December 1987, pursuant to rule 11 of the Rules of Procedures of the Executive Board.
- 2. At its sixty-first session, the Executive Board decided that the Evaluation Committee's membership should be in line with the current composition of the Executive Board, as follows:

List A: 4 seats List B: 2 seats List C: 3 seats

- 3. The seats would be inclusive of the chairperson. It was further agreed that the chair of the Evaluation Committee would rest permanently with Lists B and C, and that rotation of the chair was the prerogative of List B and C members.
- 4. At its sixty-eighth session, the Executive Board approved the terms of reference and rules of procedure of the Evaluation Committee, in line with the decision taken at the Board's sixty-first session. In light of its approval in April 2003 of the IFAD Evaluation Policy, the Executive Board approved, at its eighty-third session, further revision of the Committee's terms of reference and rules of procedure. These new terms of reference and rules of procedure can be accessed on the IFAD website (document EB 2004/83/R.7/Rev.1).
- 5. At its eighty-seventh session, the Executive Board endorsed the appointment of the following members to the Evaluation Committee for a term of office to end in April 2009:

List A: Belgium, Germany, Sweden and Switzerland List B: Indonesia and Nigeria List C: Sub-List C1: Cameroon (for the years 2006 and 2007) Mali (for the year 2008) Sub-List C2: India Sub-List C3: Mexico

B. Requested decision

- 6. In accordance with rule 11.1 of the Rules of Procedures of the Executive Board and rule 3 of the Rules of Procedure of the Evaluation Committee, the Executive Board is hereby invited to approve the appointment of the members of the Evaluation Committee for the three-year period ending in April 2012.
- 7. The attachment to this document, provided for reference purposes, sets out the new Executive Board composition as elected at the thirty-second session of the Governing Council on 19 February 2009.
