Progress report on implementation of the performance-based allocation system

Addendum

1. The Executive Board is invited to take note of the attached additional information relating to the progress report on implementation of the performance-based allocation system (EB 2009/98/R.56).
2. Annex I contains the 2009 country scores by region and the country allocations for the Eighth Replenishment (2010-2012), indicating both the annual country allocations for 2010 and the updated, indicative, country allocations for the 2011-2012 period. In order to improve the management of allocations in the three-year period, amounts for countries that are expected to use only part of their potential allocation have been capped at the expected level of financing. This has also included minimum allocation countries that have already used part of their 2010-2012 allocation for programmes approved in 2007-2009.
3. Annex II presents details of the rural development sector framework assessments for 2009, in line with the criteria for such assessments set out in document EB 2003/80/R.3. These assessments form the basis for the rural sector performance score in the total performance rating used for the country score and country allocation.
