Start a Corporate-level Evaluation on IFAD11 and IFAD12, to be completed in 2025

Complete a Thematic Evaluation on IFAD's support to human nutrition

Prepare a new edition of the Annual Report on Independent Evaluation (ARIE), to include dedicated analysis on co-financing and a review of the evidence of effects of COVID 19 on IFAD project performance

- Start a new evaluation on IFAD's interventions in Small Island Development States

Project level


- Project Performance Evaluations in: Cabo Verde, Lesotho, Montenegro and Sri Lanka

IOE proposes adding one P4 staff post to its complement. To enhance IOE's coverage of country programmes (at the moment capacity is at about half of requests for CSPEs)
