FORGE CORPORATE CULTURE

Contribute to forging IFAD's corporate culture as a transparent, learning-oriented and accountable organization.





IMPROVE COVERAGE

Improve evaluation coverage and promote transformative evaluations that reflect the scale and scope of IFAD operations.

BUILD EVALUATION DIALOGUES

Engage with Management, Member States and external partners to support evaluation capacity and use within and outside IFAD.





RETAIN & DEEPEN LEADERSHIP

Retain and deepen IOE's position as an internationally recognized leader in the evaluation of rural development programmes, policies and strategies.



Transparent, learning-oriented and accountable organization: 2025 Highlights



- Thematic Evaluation on IFAD-funded interventions in human nutrition
- Evaluation on IFAD's experience in the Small Island Development States
- Planned completion of CLE on IFAD11 and IFAD12
- Annual Report on the Independent Evaluation of IFAD (ARIE), with analysis on sustainability of benefits
- Increased CSPE coverage 5 completed and presented to the EC and 9 scheduled for completion by end of 2025. 69% of COSOPs going to the EB will be preceded by a CSPE – up from 56% in 2024 and 20% in 2023.
- Continued thought leadership and knowledge generation: Chair of Evaluation Cooperation Group, AfrEA keynote, AI for Good Summit, ReLAC keynote, Asian Evaluation Week


- Corporate-level evaluation (CLE) of IFAD's Human Resource Policy Framework
- **CLE on Supplementary Funding**
- Sub-regional evaluation (SRE) on conflict-affected states in the Near East and North Africa
- Continued increased coverage in 2026 with 23 total evaluations: 14 CSPEs, 5 PPEs, 2 project cluster evaluations, 1 SRE, 2 CLEs
- Annual Report on the Independent Evaluation of IFAD (ARIE). Annual topic for the ARIE to be decided in consultation with the governing bodies and IFAD Management






Significantly increased evaluation coverage

CSPE growth 2021-2026









Furthering IOE's leadership in evaluation and accountability

- In coordination with Management, undergo the **External Peer Review of the IFAD evaluation function**, in 2026, led by ECG, covering self- and independent evaluation
- Engage with international evaluation networks (ECG, UNEG, IntEVAL)
- IOE will co-host the UN Evaluation Group in February 2026.
- Engage with its Evaluation Advisory Panel, hold the fourth workshop in 2026

Capacity development

- IOE to continue to organize on demand seminars on evaluation practices and evaluation methodology
- Continue support to the Global Evaluation Initiative, led by the World Bank's Independent Evaluation Group, in collaboration with the World Bank's Independent Evaluation Group



Budgeting for human resources



IOE continues with model of staff leading evaluations



Slight increase in staff complement in 2026 (1 P3).

• Staff profile reflects diversity of IFAD operations: 16 nationalities and 9 languages



Value for money: IOE has more than doubled coverage with a less than 20% budget increase



In September 2025, IOE will work on an updated estimate in consultation with the Planning, Organizational Development and Budget Division of IFAD



Budget Implications

IOE budget in US\$ million (2010-2026)



- Proposed 2026 budget is a 7.55%
 increase from 2025, as a right sizing visà-vis its increased programme of work
 to meet evaluation demand, learning
 and accountability needs
- IOE's proposed budget is a 0.69% of the estimated PoLG – well below its 0.9% cap
