1. **Opening of the session**

The 135th session of the Evaluation Committee will be held on Wednesday, 21 October 2026, at IFAD headquarters, Via Paolo di Dono 44, Rome. The session will take place in the Oval Room (S-120) from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The provisional agenda of the 135th session is contained in the present document.

3. **Results-based work programme and budget for 2027 and indicative plan for 2028-2029 of the Independent Office of Evaluation of IFAD**

The document contains the proposed results-based work programme and budget for 2027, and indicative plan for 2028–2029 of the Independent Office of Evaluation of IFAD, for consideration by the Committee before submission to the Executive Board in December. The document builds on discussions with the Evaluation Committee at its 134th session, with the Audit Committee at its 182nd meeting, and with the Executive Board at its 148th session, in September 2026.

4. **Country strategy and programme evaluation for the Republic of Zimbabwe**

The country strategy and programme evaluation for the Republic of Zimbabwe is the first such evaluation conducted in the country by the Independent Office of Evaluation of IFAD (IOE). It covers the period 2016–2025. The evaluation assesses the results and performance of the IFAD-financed strategy and programme in Zimbabwe and presents findings and recommendations for the future partnership between the Government and IFAD. The Committee is also invited to review the related agreement at completion point signed by the Government and IFAD Management, which is contained in the addendum.

5. **Country strategy and programme evaluation for the Republic of Tunisia**

The country strategy and programme evaluation for the Republic of Tunisia is the third such evaluation conducted in the country by IOE. It covers the period 2019–2025. The evaluation assesses the results and performance of the IFAD-financed strategy and programme in Tunisia and presents findings and recommendations for the future partnership between the Government and IFAD. The Committee is also invited to review the related agreement at completion point signed by the Government and IFAD Management, which is contained in the addendum.

6. **Country strategy and programme evaluation for the Republic of Côte d'Ivoire**

The country strategy and programme evaluation for the Republic of Côte d'Ivoire is the first such evaluation conducted in the country by IOE. It covers the period 2013–2024. The evaluation assesses the results and performance of the IFAD-financed strategy and programme in Côte d'Ivoire and presents findings and recommendations for the future partnership between the Government and IFAD. The Committee is also invited to review the related agreement at completion point signed by the Government and IFAD Management, which is contained in the addendum.

7. **Provisional agenda of the Evaluation Committee for 2027**

In line with the Revised IFAD Evaluation Policy and the Terms of Reference and Rules of Procedure of the Evaluation Committee of the Executive Board, the document contains the proposed provisional agenda for Evaluation Committee sessions to be held in 2027, for consideration by Committee members.

8. **Country strategy and programme evaluation for the Republic of Peru**

The country strategy and programme evaluation for the Republic of Peru is the second such evaluation conducted in the country by IOE. It covers the period

2017–2024. The evaluation assesses the results and performance of the IFAD-financed strategy and programme in Peru and presents findings and recommendations for the future partnership between the Government and IFAD. The Committee is also invited to review the related agreement at completion point signed by the Government and IFAD Management, which is contained in the addendum.
