BUDGET STRUCTURE OF THE OFFICE OF EVALUATION AND STUDIES

As a consequence of the introduction of new evaluation activities over the years, the structure of the budget allocation for evaluation and studies was defined under nine sub-items in the approved budget for 2001 (see attachment) so as to reflect the different types of evaluation work undertaken by the Office of Evaluation and Studies (OE). The annual work programme of OE is the result of a broad, ongoing consultation process both within and outside IFAD. As a general rule, it is only in December of any given year that OE is in a position to determine the type and number of evaluations that will be undertaken during the course of the following year, and the resources to be allocated to each budget line. It follows, therefore, that when the budget proposal is dispatched to Executive Board members in October, OE can have only a very approximate idea of the evaluation work that will be undertaken during the following year. To avoid unnecessary requests for reallocations of funds between budget items during the course of the year and to ensure that more efficient use is made of available human resources, it is proposed to simplify the budget structure for evaluation and studies, namely, to reduce the number of sub-items from nine to two. The proposed budget structure as of 2002 would therefore appear as follows:
