Office of Evaluation country programme and project evaluations for 2009 and 2010

- In the course of the sixtieth session of the Evaluation Committee, members requested that the Office of Evaluation (OE) provide the Committee with a list of evaluations for consideration at its sixty-first session, in January 2010. This would permit the Committee to refine, as needed, its agenda for 2010, which the Board provisionally adopted during its session in December 2009. The Committee's provisional agenda for 2010 is presented in annex I.
- 2. The principles guiding the development of the Committee's provisional agenda are: (i) the need to discuss evaluation items in line with the Terms of Reference and Rules of Procedure of the Evaluation Committee; and (ii) the importance of discussing all corporate-level evaluations and maintaining a regional balance in country programme and project evaluations.
