Introduction

- WPB determined based on a critical assessment of needs
- Developed independently, yet informed by comprehensive discussions with IFAD Management and PMD
- IOE WP based on two strategic objectives:
 - > SO1: Contribute, through independent evaluation work, to enhancing accountability for results; and
 - > SO2: Promote effective learning and knowledge management to further strengthen the performance of IFAD operations

Selection of proposed activities in the 2015 Work Programme – Key Outputs

 2015 Annual Report on the Results and Impact of IFAD Operations (ARRI)

- Corporate-level evaluations (CLE):
 - IFAD's work in fragile and conflict-affected states and situations
 - A new CLE, on smallholder agriculture for rural poverty reduction (working title)

Selection of proposed activities in the 2015 Work Programme – Key Outputs (cont.)

- Eight country programme evaluations (CPEs):
 - To be completed: Bangladesh, Sierra Leone and Tanzania
 - To start: Brazil, Ethiopia, India, Nigeria and Turkey

Selection of proposed activities in the 2015 Work Programme – Key Outputs (cont.)

- Validation of all Project Completion
 Reports (PCRVs) available in the year
- About eight Project Performance Assessments (PPAs)
- One Impact Evaluation

Selection of proposed activities in the 2015 Work Programme – Key Outputs (cont.)

- Three Evaluation Synthesis (ES):
 - Accessing markets from a sub-regional perspective;
 - Natural resources and environmental management; and
 - Non-lending activities in the context of South-South cooperation.

Selection of proposed activities in the 2015 Work Programme – Governing Bodies

- Engagement with the IFAD Governing Bodies:
 - Four regular sessions of the EC in March, July, September and October
 - Three regular sessions of the EB in April, September and December
 - Annual session of the GC in February
 - Attendance to selected AC meetings
 - Attendance to the EB Annual Country Visit
 - Preparation of the IOE WPB for 2016

Selection of proposed activities in the 2015 Work Programme – Methodology and ECD

Methodology:

- Finalize the second edition of the Evaluation Manual
- Related training of IOE staff and consultants
- Development of a new Harmonization Agreement

Evaluation Capacity Development:

- Organization of workshops in partner countries (as per request) on evaluation methodology and processes
- Implementation of Statement of Intent with China on ECD

2015 Resource Envelope

- Staff resources
 - Increase of a 0.5 staff year (Evaluation knowledge and Communication
 Officer converted from part-time to full-time position)
- Assumptions provided by IFAD Budget Unit
 - Inflation rate of 2.5% for non staff costs
 - No increase in salaries
 - \blacksquare Exchange rate of USD 1 = EUR 0.72
- Proposed 2015 budget
 - USD 6.097 million (1.9 per cent nominal increase against 2014 budget, which equals to a real increase of 0.9 per cent)

Selected evaluation activities under the indicative plan for 2016-2017

- ARRI 2016
- CLEs:
 - > IFAD's decentralization model and experience;
 - IFAD's approach and results in policy dialogue;
 - > IFAD's efforts in conducting impact evaluations; and
 - Joint evaluation with FAO and WFP of Reformed Committee on World Food Security.
- □ **CPES:** Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cameroon, Malawi, The Philippines, Indian Ocean small island developing states, Sub-regional evaluation in English-speaking Caribbean island countries
- □ **ES:** IFAD's experience on value chains; Remittances; Opportunities and challenges for scaling up to achieve a wider impact on rural poverty; and IFAD's self-evaluation mechanism.
- One Impact evaluation (project to be decided)
- PCRVs and PPAs
