Opportunities for the future (selected)

- Rationalize travels and reduce the 'carbon footprint' of evaluations
- Enhance efficiency of country missions through a combination of remote and face-to-face in-country interviews; and greater emphasis on project site visits
- Exploit the potential of information technology to augment evidence and analyse secondary evidence. (e.g., remote sensing, software for qualitative analysis, machine learning)
- Recognize the challenges early on and manage the annual evaluation workplan accordingly
