Note to Delegates Governing Council 2019 – Forty-second session

Access to Plenary Hall

The plenary meetings of the Governing Council will be held in the Plenary Hall of FAO. Due to the limited seating capacity of the Plenary Hall, three seats will be assigned per delegation and plenary passes will be required to access the Plenary.

Delegates are cordially invited to collect their meeting badges in advance at the Registration desk in the Security Pavilion located at the main entrance to FAO, on Viale Aventino next to the metro station, at the following times:

• Tuesday, 12 February: 10.00-17.00

• Wednesday, 13 February: 10.00-17.00

Thursday, 14 February: 08.00-8.30 and from approximately 11.00-18.30

Friday, 15 February: 08.00-closure of the session

Important: Please note that there will be no access to FAO premises on the morning of 14 February between 8.30 a.m. and approximately 11 a.m. due to strict security measures being implemented for the visit of His Holiness Pope Francis. As a result, during this time frame the Registration desk will be closed.

Interventions during business items
