



## G20 Briefing by India

India holds the Presidency of the G20 this year under the theme “Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam” or “One Earth, One Family, One Future”. The Heads of State and Government Summit will take place on 9-10 September 2023 in New Delhi, following several meetings with ministers, senior officials and civil societies over the course of the year.

IFAD, as the only multilateral development institution that focuses exclusively on transforming rural economies and food systems, is supporting the India Presidency in areas related to agriculture and rural development.

This briefing will be an opportunity for IFAD Member States to learn and exchange information about the India Presidency’s priorities and their linkages to IFAD’s mandate.
