1. **Opening of the session**

The forty-eighth session of the Governing Council will be held on Wednesday, 12 February and Thursday, 13 February 2025.

2. Adoption of the agenda

The provisional agenda, prepared by the President and approved by the Executive Board in accordance with rule 6 of the Rules of Procedure of the Governing Council, is contained in the present document.

3. Statement of the President of IFAD

The President of IFAD will make a statement to the Governing Council.

4. **Report on the Thirteenth Replenishment of IFAD's Resources**

A report on the status of the Thirteenth Replenishment of IFAD's Resources will be presented.

5. IFAD's 2025 results-based programme of work, regular and capital budgets, and budget outlook for 2026–2027, the Independent Office of Evaluation of IFAD's results-based work programme and budget for 2025 and indicative plan for 2026–2027, and the HIPC, PBAS and BRAM progress reports

As recommended by the Executive Board, the budgets of IFAD and the Independent Office of Evaluation of IFAD (IOE) for 2025 will be presented for the approval of the Governing Council, together with a draft resolution thereon. Additionally, IFAD's budget outlook for 2026–2027, IOE's indicative work plan for 2026–2027 as well as the progress reports on IFAD's participation in the Heavily Indebted Poor Countries (HIPC) Initiative, and the implementation of IFAD's performance-based allocation system (PBAS) and the Borrowed Resource Allocation Mechanism (BRAM) will be presented for the information of the Council.

6. Amendments to IFAD's basic legal texts

Document GC 48/L.4 will contain proposed revisions to section 6 of the By-laws for the Conduct of the Business of IFAD to amend the internal legal framework and to render effective the Policy on Handling Allegations of Misconduct against the President of IFAD as approved by the Executive Board.

7. Annual Joint Progress Report on Rome-based Agency Collaboration

Since 2016, a joint progress report has been prepared each year and presented to the respective governing bodies of the Rome-based agencies (RBAs). This report serves as an annual update on how RBA collaboration is harnessing the unique strengths of each agency for maximum impact. The report underscores the significance of collaboration for the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals and highlights the critical efforts of teams on the ground as well as at headquarters.

8. Other business
